"How could God allow this?"

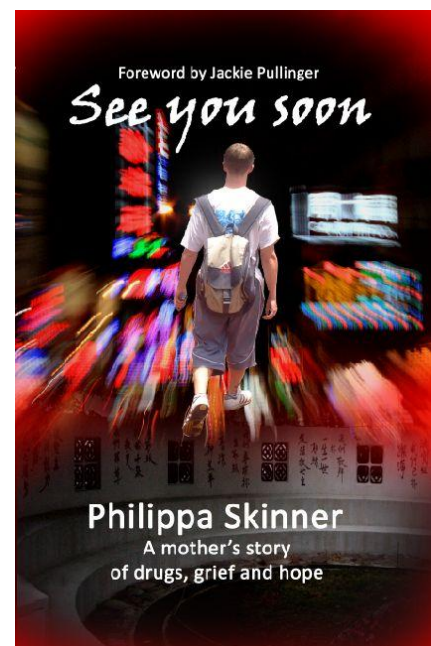
"Are you even there, God?"
